- Japan** **Beef Tataki** **£7.50**
Seared rare slices of sirloin with mixed leaves, sake, ginger and orange dressing.
- Canton** **Yu Sang** **£6.90**
Stir Fried Sea-bass with crispy noodles, spring onion, ginger, chilli and peanuts.
- Hong Kong** **Ha Kuen** **£6.70**
Deep fried Filo pastry parcel, filled with prawns, bacon, cheese, spring onion, carrot with a zesty shot of sweet chilli lime sauce.
- Thai** **Mieng Hed Rolls** **£6.50**
Crispy spring rolls with minced mixed mushroom, lime, ginger, fresh peppercorns, coriander and garlic.

Mains

- Malaysia** **Nonya Sea-bream Curry** **£13.50**
Crispy fried Sea-bream fillet with Malaysia Nonya curry sauce topped with spring onion, chilli and curry leaves.
- Hong Kong** **Special Black bean Salmon** **£13.90**
Steamed Salmon fillet with a pickled plum, ginger, garlic, chilli and black beans.
- Sichuan** **Yorkshire Lamb Cutlets** **£17.90**
Chargrilled lamb Chop with bean sprout, black fungus, spring onions and a Sichuan peppercorn chilli sauce
